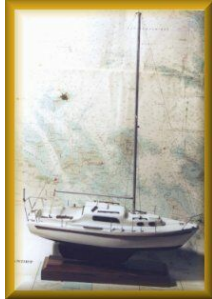
Workshop DE IJSEL COATINGS
